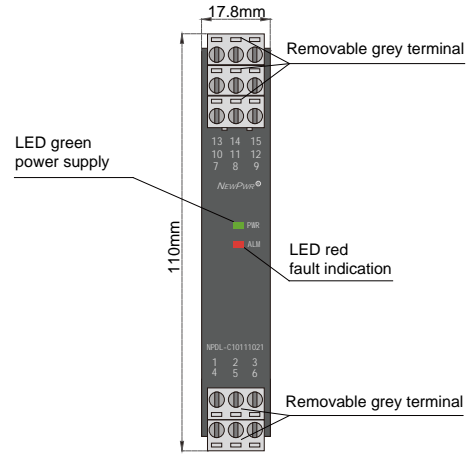
Single input, single output

Input: 0 ~ 60 V AC
Output: 4 ~ 20 mA

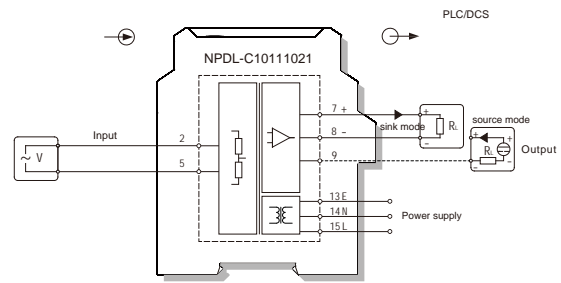
This AC voltage transmitter converts the 0 ~ 60 V AC signals to current signals. It needs an independent power supply. The input, output, and power supply are galvanically isolated from each other.
